2007 was a record year in Kansas. Every county in the state was declared a Disaster area at one time or another. Some counties were declared disaster areas more than once. In response to the tornadoes and flooding that occurred during the first part of 2007, the Chapters at Regional Summer Planning 2007 voted to raise money for a fund that would benefit members who were affected by these natural disasters. In fall 2007, \$1000 was designated to aid 3 members who were affected by the floods in Southeastern Kansas.

This is a voluntary project. It is our hope that all chapters will feel led to contribute to this fund. In 2007 we had 1769 new members inducted in the Kansas region. If each chapter committed to donating \$1/new member each semester, we could make a huge difference in the lives of members affected by natural disasters.
